- 1. Opening of the meeting
  - Meeting was officially called to order at 12pm.
- 2. Approval of Agenda
  - Be it resolved that the November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, agenda be approved unanimously.

- 3. Approval of Minutes from September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024
  - Be it resolved that the September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024, minutes be approved unanimously.
- 4. Roundtable
  - The sub-committee members share updates from their day job.
  - A quick discussion was held regarding locals and local AGM.

  - There were two significant issues raised by locals:

- 6. Onboarding sessions: Next steps
  - The locals who conduct onboarding sessions receive great feedback as compared to the ones who don't.

- A. Yeo also suggests creating onboarding deck and emailing it to all locals, with steps for inclusion in onboarding session.
- W. Harrison brings up a conversation regarding membership lists.
- A. Brabant mentions inviting union representatives to the onboarding sessions.
- 7. New initiatives: Starting a Local Starter Clinic
  - A dedicated period for local presidents to present some questions, such as how to approach an issue.
  - The sub-committee discuss coaching sessions, improving union tracking and communication for new members.
  - A. Brabant promotes the idea of a federal workers subcommittee and local clinic to support members in different situations.
