#### 4. Debrief on the education event- Trump and Poilievre

- The Trump and Poilievre event went very well and had a record number of participants, being about 230 members online and 40 in person.
- The panelists were excellent, with sharp analysis.
- N. Burron expresses the key focus of ensuring that the economic struggle doesn't completely eclipse the struggle against oppression and discrimination of particular groups.
- B. McDougall emphasizes the need to compile questions and issues raised during the event for future agenda-setting.
- A. Yeo suggests adding forecasting future events to the agenda.
- B. McDougall proposes a study group to address issues raised during the Trump Poilievre event.

### 5. Next steps in planning for WFA event

- N. Burron introduces the WFA event, emphasizing the need for a technical and political discussion.
- A. Poliquin outlines CAPE's plans for WFA, including a guide, FAQ document, and consultation on departmental WFA committees.

- M. Favreau highlights the need for a recording of the event and the interest from members.
- N. Burron summarizes the consensus on having two events: one technical and one political.
- N. Burron discusses the need for a CAPE national staff member to present the guide.
- B. McDougall offers to speak about the politics of fighting workforce adjustment.
- N. Burron and A. Poliquin plan to coordinate with CAPE staff for a more detailed event plan.
